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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT in addition to and to amend chapter 634, Private  
and Special Laws of 1893, as amended by chapter 50 Private  
and Special Laws of 1895, relating to the Hampden and  
Winterport Electric Railway and Light Company.

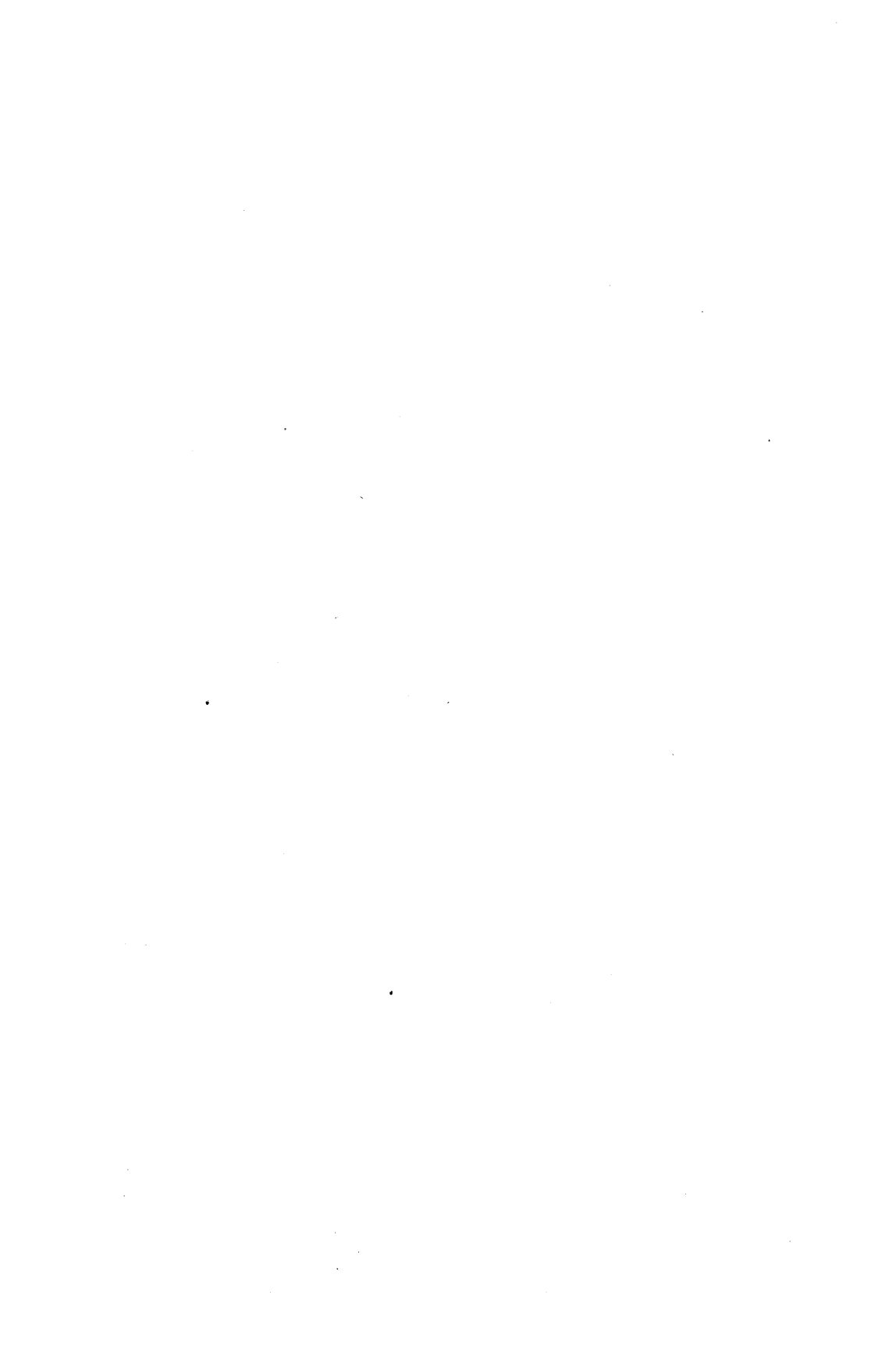
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The doings of the stockholders of the Hamp-  
2 den and Winterport Railway at a special meeting duly called  
3 and held in the city of Bangor on the thirtieth day of  
4 December, 1896, relative to the change of the name of said  
5 corporation so that thereafter it should be called the 'Ban-  
6 gor, Hampden and Winterport Railway,' is approved. And

7 the name of said corporation is changed to the 'Bangor,  
8 Hampden and Winterport Railway.'

Sect. 2. This action shall take effect when approved.
