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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to amend section thirty-one of chapter eighty-three  
of the Revised Statutes relating to Unpaid Executions issued  
by Deceased Trial Justices.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section thirty-one of chapter eighty-three of  
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting the  
3 words 'or who has deceased' between the words "commis-  
4 sioned" and "may" in the third line thereof, so that said  
5 section shall read as follows:

'Section 31. Executions remaining unsatisfied, in whole  
7 or in part, issued by a trial justice whose commission has  
8 expired, or who has removed from the county for which he

9 was commissioned, or who has deceased, may be renewed  
10 by any trial justice in the same county, upon such vouchers  
11 as would be required by the trial justice who rendered the  
12 judgment.'
