STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Jefferson.

Resolved, That there be paid to the town of Jefferson out
2 of the school fund for 1897 the sum of two hundred and
3 forty-eight and 50-100 (248.50) dollars, on account of an
4 error made in returning the number of scholars from that
5 town for the year 1895.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In April, 1895, an enumeration of persons between the ages of 4 and 21 was made in the town of Jefferson and it was found that there were 374 persons of school age.

In making his return to the State superintendent of schools the superintendent of Jefferson made an error and reported 274 instead of 374 as the number of scholars in the town, thereby causing a loss to the town of \$248.50.

The number of scholars returned from the town of Jefferson in 1894 was 386 and the number returned in 1896 was 379.
