STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for an appropriation for Marking the Position held by the Third Regiment of Infantry, Maine Volunteers, on the Battlefield of Gettysburg.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated for the purpose of erecting a tablet, 3 with suitable inscription thereon, to mark the position held 4 by the Third Regiment of Infantry, Maine Volunteers, while 5 in support of the Second Corps, on the battlefield of Gettys- 6 burg, during "Longstreet's assault," July third, eighteen 7 hundred and sixty-three.
