STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to secure the Proper Enforcement of the Inland Fish and Game Laws, and to aid in the propagation of Inland Fish and Game.

Resolved, That the sum of forty thousand dollars is hereby
2 appropriated to be expended by the commissioners of inland
3 fisheries and game, under the direction of the Governor and
4 Council, for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven,
5 and also forty thousand dollars for the year eighteen hun-
6 dred and ninety-eight, for the purpose of the proper enforce-
7 ment of the inland fish and game laws, and to aid in the
8 propagation of inland fish and game. Provided, also, that
9 the commissioners of inland fisheries and game may pur-
10 chase or lease real estate, in the name of the State, for the
11 purpose of maintaining hatcheries for fish culture, and may

12 also assist in maintaining hatcheries for fish culture owned
13 and under the management of fish and game associations;
14 and provided, also, that the commissioners shall make a
15 detailed statement in their report of all expenditures of
16 money expended under this resolve.
