STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Farmington State Normal School.

Resolved, That for the completion of the new main school 2 building of the Farmington State Normal School, there be 3 and hereby is appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars 4 for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and the 5 like sum of ten thousand dollars for the year eighteen hun-6 dred and ninety-eight, the said sums to be expended under 7 the direction of the trustees of State normal schools.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The legislature of 1895 appropriated the sum of \$20,000 toward the erection of a new main school building for the Farmington State Normal School. When this appropriation was made, it was understood that it would be insufficient to complete the building and that a further appropriation would be necessary from the legislature of 1897. The amount required is shown by the detailed statement given below, which is based upon estimates of the architect and on actual bids from reliable contractors.
