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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT additional to and amendatory of chapter 48, of the  
Private and Special Laws of 1887, entitled "An Act to incor-  
porate the Winterport Ferry Company."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Said company may take and hold any lands  
2 necessary for landings, piers, wharves, or for any purpose  
3 so far as consistent with said company's charter. It may  
4 enter upon lands to make surveys and locations, and shall  
5 file in the registry of deeds, of the county, where such lands  
6 are located, plans for said location and lands showing the  
7 property taken.

Sect. 2. Should the said company and the owner of such  
2 land be unable to agree upon the damages to be paid for  
3 such location, taking, holding and construction, the land  
4 owner may within twelve months after said filing of plans  
5 of location, apply to the county commissioners of said  
6 county and cause such damages to be assessed in the same  
7 manner and under the same conditions, restrictions and  
8 limitations, as are by law prescribed in the case of damages  
9 by the laying out of highways, so far as such law is consist-  
10 ent with the provisions of this act.

Sect. 3. Said company may issue its bonds in sums of not  
2 less than one hundred dollars each at such rates and on  
3 such time or times as is expedient for the purposes under  
4 its charter, provided that said bonds issued shall not at any  
5 time exceed in amount the capital stock of the company  
6 issued at that time and paid for, and may secure the same  
7 by mortgage of its franchise and property or in any other  
8 manner it may deem proper, and may hold stock in other  
9 corporations.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
