STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT authorizing the City of Lewiston to Refund a Part
of its Debt.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. To meet its bonds now outstanding and
2 maturing in the year one thousand eight hundred and
3 ninety-seven, the city of Lewiston is authorized to issue
4 bonds to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand
5 dollars, payable at a period or periods not exceeding thirty
6 years after the date thereof, and bearing interest at a rate
7 not exceeding four per cent. per annum, payable semi-
8 annually. Said bonds shall be issued under the seal of the
9 city and shall be signed by the mayor and treasurer of the

10 city, and the coupons attached to said bonds shall be signed
11 by the city treasurer.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
