STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN .

AN ACT enabling the Town of Yarmouth to Build and Main-
tain a bridge across tide waters between the islands of
Cousin's and Littlejohn's in said town of Yarmouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Yarmouth, in the county of
2 Cumberland, is hereby authorized to erect and maintain a
3 bridge, for foot and carriage travel, across tide waters,
4 between Cousin's and Littlejohn's islands in said town, said
5 bridge to be without a draw.
