STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to incorporate Newfield Academy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Ai Q. Mitchell, Leroy O. Straw, Albert H.
2 Davis, George E. Mitchell, Everett E. Ham, James M.
3 Moulton, Asa F. Horne, David W. Libby, Charles W.
4 Straw, Charles Moulton and Mark W. Dunnells, their asso-
5 ciates, successors and assigns, are hereby constituted a cor-
6 poration by the name of the Trustees of Newfield Acad-
7 emy, and by that name may sue and be sued, have a com-
8 mon seal, make such by-laws, not repugnant to the laws of

9 this State, as they may deem expedient for the manage-
10 ment of their affairs, fill all vacancies occurring in their
11 number, take and hold any estate, real or personal that they
12 now possess or may hereafter receive by donation or other-
13 wise, the annual income of which shall not exceed two thou-
14 sand dollars, said income to be faithfully applied to promote
15 the cause of education, and the trustees aforesaid are
16 entrusted with all the privileges and powers incident to
17 similar corporations.

Sect. 2. Any one of the incorporators named in this act
2 is hereby authorized to fix the time and place of first meet-
3 ing of said trustees, and to give each four days notice there-
4 of in writing.
