STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to authorize the Infusorial Earth Company to lower
the Waters of Noyes pond, in the town of Bluehill, during
certain months in the year.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Infusorial Earth Company, a corporation
2 existing under the laws of the State of Maine, is hereby
3 authorized and empowered to lower the waters of Noyes
4 pond in Bluehill, Hancock county, Maine, to the extent of
5 three feet, by excavating the outlet of said pond, for the
6 term of fifteen years from the date of the approval of this

7 act, during the months of June, July, August and Septem-
8 ber, each year, and said corporation shall, at its own expense,
9 during the remaining eight months of each year during said
10 term, keep the waters of said pond at their natural height
11 by constructing and maintaining a dam at said outlet.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
