IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to establish a Bounty on Wildcats.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1 A bounty of two dollars for every wildcat killed  
2 in any town or township shall be paid by the treasurer  
3 thereof to the person killing it, upon compliance with the  
4 conditions provided by law in the case of the bounty upon  
5 wolves and bears. If the place of killing is an unorganized  
6 plantation, the bounty shall be paid by the treasurer of any  
7 adjoining town if any, otherwise by the treasurer of the  
8 town nearest said plantation. The bounties so paid shall  
9 be repaid to such towns or townships upon the terms pro-  
10 vided in section seven of chapter thirty of the Revised  
11 Statutes.

Sect. 2 This act shall take effect when approved.
