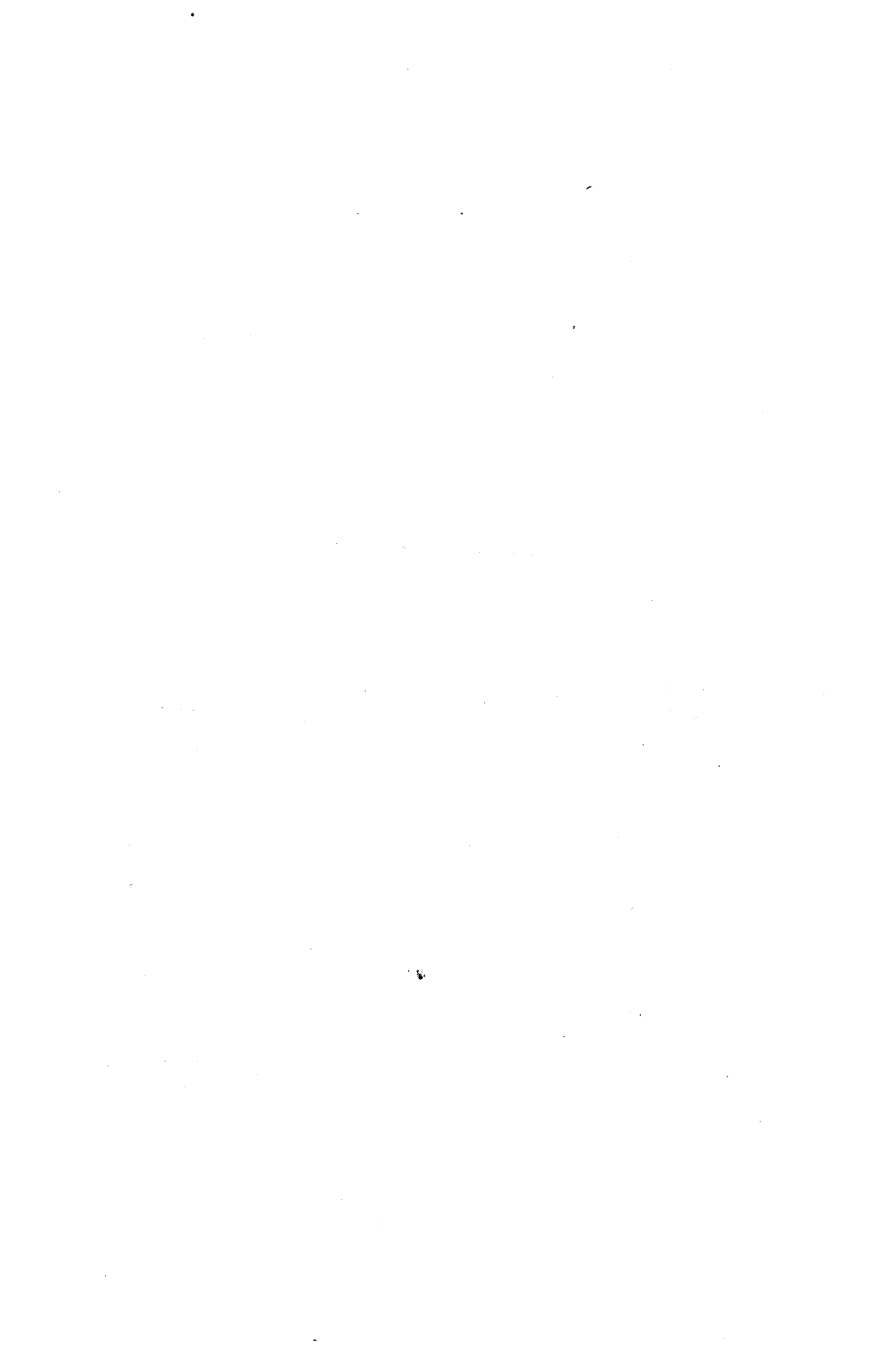

RESOLVE relating to a settling lot in Drew Plantation.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to
2 Mrs. J. F. Belden of Drew Plantation the tract of land now
3 occupied by her as a homestead farm. The price for said
4 land not to exceed one dollar per acre and the proceeds
5 from such sale to be deposited in the State treasury to the
6 credit of the school fund of said Drew Plantation, as said
7 tract of land is a part of the reserved lands of said township.
