STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT requiring all Educational Institutions receiving State Aid to make reports and to account for receipts and expenditures to the Trustees of the State Normal Schools, said reports to be published as a part of the Annual Report of the State Superintendent of Public Schools, on penalty of forfeiting such aid.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Every educational institution receiving State
2 aid shall report to the trustees of the State normal schools
3 the total and average attendance, receipts and expenditures,

4 number of instructors, number and length of terms, with
5 attendance for each, and answer such other questions as
6 they shall determine.

Sect. 2. Every such educational institution failing to com-
2 ply with the above requirements or failing to have an attend-
3 ance of at least fifty students who are pursuing academic
4 studies shall forfeit whatever aid or assistance it would
5 otherwise receive from the State.
