STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Oakfield.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Township number five in the third range of
2 townships, west from the east line of the State of Maine,
3 heretofore known as Oakfield plantation, is hereby incor-
4 porated as a town under the name of Oakfield; and the
5 inhabitants thereof are hereby invested with all the powers
6 and privileges and subject to the duties and liabilities inci-
7 dent to other towns in this State.

Sect. 2. The collectors of the plantation of Oakfield shall
2 have power to finish the collection of all taxes which shall
3 have been committed to them for collection prior to the

4 passage of this act, and to settle with and pay the same to
5 the treasurer of the town of Oakfield; and the several offi-
6 cers of said plantation are empowered to perform all the
7 duties of town officers in the town created by this act, until
8 their successors shall have been legally chosen and qualified
9 as town officers of the town of Oakfield under this act.

Sect. 3. Any justice of the peace, may call the first meet-
2 ing of the town of Oakfield, by posting a warrant therefor,
3 stating the objects of said meeting, in three public and con-
4 spicuous places in said town, at least seven days before the
5 time of holding said meeting.

Sect. 4. All property now belonging to Oakfield planta-
2 tion shall belong to, and the title thereof is hereby vested
3 in the town of Oakfield.

Sect. 5. The persons hereafter becoming chargeable as
2 paupers within the limits of said town shall be chargeable
3 to said town of Oakfield, excepting the following named
4 State paupers to wit: Melinda Davis, James Robb, Samuel
5 C. Libby, John Corliss, Albertus Nickerson and Martha
6 Nickerson, Gilbert Libby and Ora Libby.

Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
