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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to amend sections 1 and 2 of chapter 356, of the  
Private and Special Laws of 1885, relating to the salary of the  
treasurer of the county of Waldo.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 356 of the Private and  
2 Special Laws of 1885, is hereby amended as follows:

By striking out the word "three" in the third line of said  
4 section, and inserting, instead thereof, the word 'four,' so  
5 that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The salary of the treasurer of Waldo county,  
7 shall be fixed by the county commissioners but it shall not  
8 exceed four hundred dollars for each year, and in that pro-  
9 portion for any fractional part of a year.'

Section 2. Section 2 of said act is amended by striking  
2 out from section 2 of said act, the words "eighty-five," and  
3 inserting instead thereof, the word 'ninety-seven.' So that  
4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of  
6 January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.'
