STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend sections 1 and 2 of chapter 356, of the Private and Special Laws of 1885, relating to the salary of the treasurer of the county of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled. as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 356 of the Private and 2 Special Laws of 1885, is hereby amended as follows:

By striking out the word "three" in the third line of said 4 section, and inserting, instead thereof, the word 'four,' so 5 that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The salary of the treasurer of Waldo county, 7 shall be fixed by the county commissioners but it shall not 8 exceed four hundred dollars for each year, and in that pro-9 portion for any fractional part of a year.'

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Section 2. Section 2 of said act is amended by striking 2 out from section 2 of said act, the words "eighty-five," and 3 inserting instead thereof, the word 'ninety-seven.' So that 4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of o January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.' .
