STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section 4 of chapter 308, of the Private and
Special Laws of 1889, as amended by section 1, chapter 232,
of the Private and Special Laws of 1891.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 4 of chapter 308, of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1889, as amended by section 1, chapter 232,
3 of the Private and Special Laws of 1891, is hereby amended
4 as follows:

By striking out that part which commences at the end of
6 the third line with the word "fifty" and continuing to the
7 word "cents" in the seventh line, and inserting the follow-
8 ing: 'Seventy-five cents for each thousand feet board

9 measure, woods scale, for all logs and lumber put into said
10 Thorn brook, and twenty-five,'—and further by striking out
11 all of said section after the word "Piscataquis" in the
12 twentieth line, and inserting the following: "The toll on all
13 logs and lumber put into said Thorn brook and manu-
14 factured at the E. A. Flanders' mill in Kingsbury, in said
15 county, shall be fifty cents for each thousand feet board
16 measure, woods scale,' so that said section as amended shall
17 read as follows:

'Section 4. The said corporation may demand and receive
19 a toll upon all logs and lumber which may pass through or
20 over said dams and improvements of said corporation, of
21 seventy-five cents for each thousand feet board measure,
22 woods scale, for all logs and lumber put into said Thorn
23 brook, and twenty-five cents for each thousand feet put into
24 the south branch of the Piscataquis river, and said corpora-
25 tion shall have a lien upon all logs and lumber which may
26 pass through or over any of its said dams and improvements
27 for the payment of said tolls, but the logs of each particular
28 mark shall be holden only for the tolls of such mark, and
29 if such toll is not paid within twenty days after such logs,
30 or a major part of them, shall arrive at Penobscot boom,
31 or place of manufacture, said corporation may seize such
32 logs and lumber and sell at public auction so many thereof
33 as shall be necessary to pay such tolls, costs and charges,
34 notice of the time and place of such sale being first given
35 ten days prior to said sale in some newspaper printed in
36 Bangor, and in the county of Piscataquis. The toll on all

37 logs and lumber put into said Thorn brook and manufac-
38 tured at the E. A. Flanders' mill in Kingsbury, in said
39 county, shall be fifty cents for each thousand feet board
40 measure, woods scale.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
