STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of an appropriation to repair the bridge
now existing across the Molunkus stream in Macwahoc Plan-
tation, County of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and
2 hereby is appropriated to repair the bridge now existing
3 across the Molunkus stream, in Macwahoc plantation, on
4 the military road from Lincoln to Houlton, and that the same
5 be expended under the direction of the county commission-
6 ers of said county of Aroostook.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The covered bridge across the Molunkus stream in the plantation of Macwahoc very much needs a pier in the middle. The butments being one hundred twenty-six feet apart have allowed the bridge to settle about sixteen inches in the middle since it was built. The bridge was built crowning eight inches, but it now sags eight inches below the ends which give it a tendency to shake the end butments when teams pass over it. It also needs clapboarding and shingling, as the rain, beating in through the leaks rots the timbers. The cost of the above would be about eight hundred dollars. This bridge was built and kept in repair by the State.
