RESOLVE to repair the Forks bridge in The Forks Plantation,  
Somerset county.

*Resolved,* That there is hereby appropriated out of any  
2 money in the treasury of the State, the sum of four hundred  
3 dollars, for repairing the Forks bridge, so called, which  
4 crosses the Kennebec river in The Forks plantation, in Som-  
5 erset county. Said money to be expended by the county  
6 commissioners of Somerset county and paid by the State  
7 when said bridge shall have been repaired.
