STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of an appropriation to repair the bridge
across Macwahoc stream in Macwahoc Plantation, county of
Aroostook.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and
2 is hereby appropriated to repair the bridge now existing
3 across the Macwahoc stream, in Macwahoc plantation, on
4 the military road from Lincoln to Houlton, and that the
5 same be expended under the direction of the county com-
6 missioners of said county of Aroostook.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridge across the Macwahoc stream, one mile east of the covered bridge on the military road, very much needs two new abutments. It sets on trestle work and the two abutments which are forty feet apart have both fallen in. The cost of this would be about five hundred dollars. This bridge was built and has always been kept in repair by the State.
