STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Breakwater at Mattawamkeag Bridge.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated to aid in repairing breakwater to pro-
3 tect the State bridge in town of Mattawamkeag, said break-
4 water to be repaired under the direction of the county com-
5 missioners of Penobscot county and the amount herein
6 appropriated is to be paid when the Governor and Council
7 are satisfied that the sum of six hundred dollars has been
8 expended for repairs on said breakwater by the town of Mat-
9 tawamkeag.
