STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT relating to the use of compressed air for power.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Any corporation organized under the laws of
2 this State, and authorized to use steam, gas, or electricity,
3 all, or either of them, may use compressed air for any pur-
4 pose for which it is authorized to use steam, gas or elec-
5 tricity, and for this purpose may establish, erect and maintain
6 suitable appliances and machinery for compressing, storing
7 and distributing compressed air and in accordance with the
8 conditions named in their respective charters for laying
9 underground pipes or erecting other appliances above the
10 ground, may lay down or maintain in or over the streets of

11 any city or town, reservoirs, pipes, and conduits, proper for
12 the storage and distribution thereof, subject to the consent
13 of, and to such rules and regulations as the municipal officers
14 of towns, or the mayor and aldermen of cities may prescribe.
