STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section sixteen of chapter two hundred and
fifty-nine of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
three, relating to Itinerant Vendors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section sixteen of chapter two hundred and
2 fifty-nine of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
3 three is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
4 words: 'but shall apply to retail sales of goods, wares and
5 merchandise made from a car, steamer or vessel,' so that said
6 section shall read as follows:

‘Section 16. The provisions of this act shall not apply to
8 sales made to dealers by commercial travellers or selling
9 agents in the usual course of business, nor to bona fide sales
10 of goods, wares and merchandise by sample for future deliv-
11 ery, or to hawkers on the streets or peddlers from vehicles,
12 but shall apply to retail sales of goods, wares and merchan-
13 dise made from a car, steamer or vessel.’
