IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

RESOLVE making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy
Tribe of Indians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Resolved, That there be paid from the State treasury, to be
2 expended under the direction of the governor and council
3 to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians, for the
4 benefit of said tribe, for the years eighteen hundred and
5 ninety-seven and eighteen hundred and ninety-eight as
6 follows: For May dividend four hundred dollars each year;
7 for November dividend four hundred dollars each year; for
8 distressed and contingent poor, three thousand five hundred
9 dollars each year; for contingent purposes one hundred and

10 fifty dollars each year; for bounty on crops two hundred
11 dollars each year; for plowing one hundred and fifty dollars
12 each year; for salary of governor one hundred dollars each
13 year; for salary of lieutenant governor forty dollars each
14 year; for wood six hundred and fifty dollars each year; for
15 dressing of land one hundred and fifty dollars each year; for
16 educational purposes eight hundred dollars each year; for
17 salary of priests two hundred dollars each year; for salary of
18 agent two hundred dollars each year; for basket ash three
19 hundred and fifty dollars each year; for agricultural pur-
20 poses six hundred dollars each year; for police fifty dollars
21 each year; for school books thirty dollars each year; for
22 repair of roads at Pleasant point one hundred dollars each
23 year; for repairs of church at Peter Dana's point one hun-
24 dred and fifty dollars in eighteen hundred and ninety-seven;
25 for repairs of school house and church at Pleasant point
26 seventy-five dollars for year eighteen hundred and ninety-
27 seven; for buying land for addition to cemetery at Pleasant
28 point two hundred and fifty dollars for year eighteen
29 hundred and ninety-seven; four hundred and twenty-eight
30 dollars and one cent to cover amounts over drawn on last
31 appropriation, to be paid to agent of said tribe in year
32 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.

All the foregoing sums to be expended under the direction
34 of governor and council for the purposes for which they are
35 appropriated, and for none other, and any money not
36 expended for the purposes for which it is appropriated shall
37 not be allowed to said agent in the settlement of his account.
