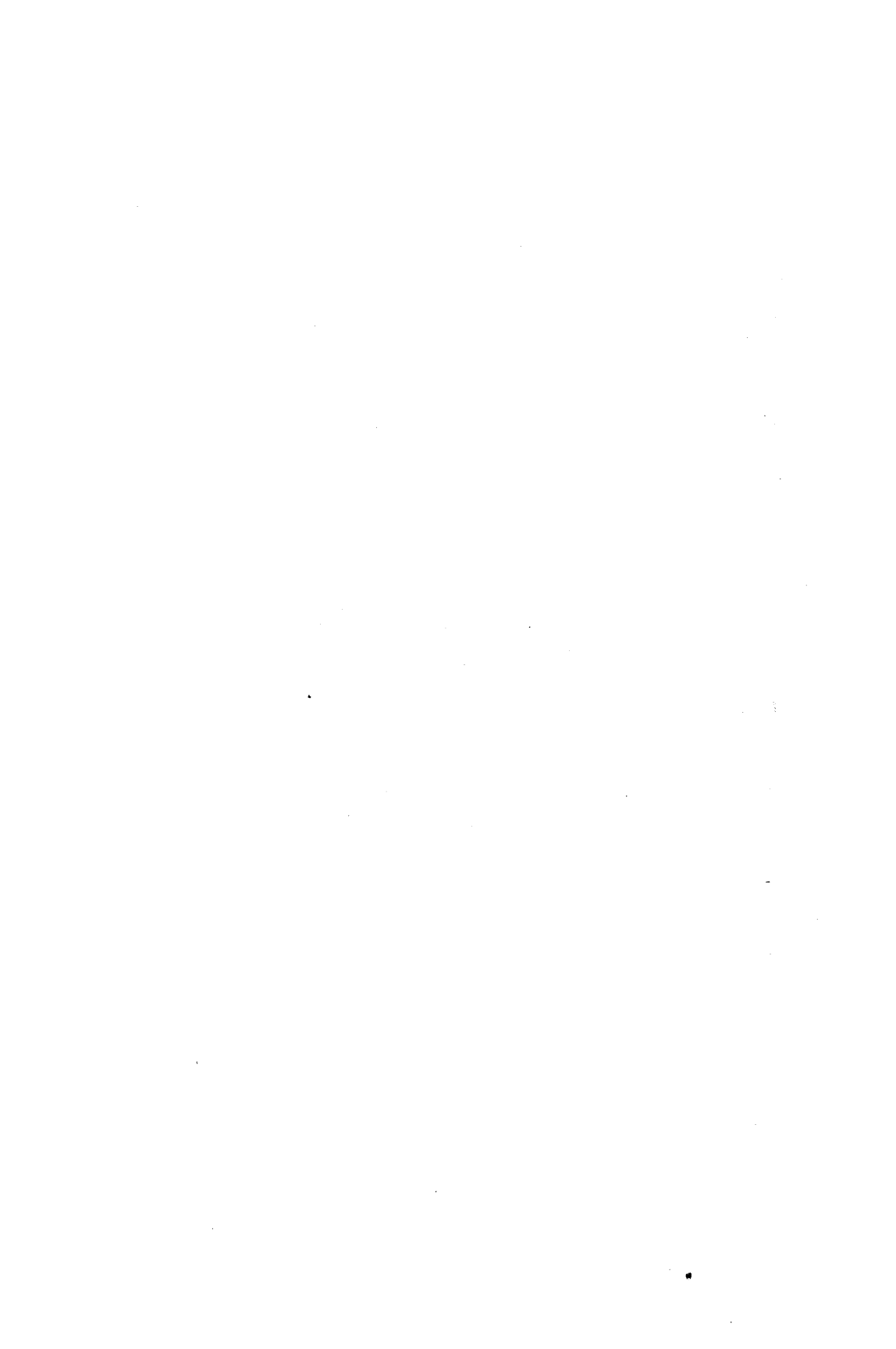
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to authorize Frederick A. Staples to build and maintain a Wharf in the tide waters of Piscataqua river in the town of Eliot, county of York.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Frederick A. Staples and his assigns, is hereby
2 authorized to erect, extend and maintain a wharf from his
3 shore front on the east side of Piscataqua river, so called,
4 into the tide waters of said Piscataqua river, in the town of
5 Eliot, county of York, at South Eliot, so called.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
