## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT additional relating to the Bath Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be appointed, by the governor, for 2 said court. a recorder, who shall keep the records of said 3 court when requested so to do by the judge; and in case 4 of the absence of the judge from the court room, or when 5 the office of judge shall be vacant, the recorder shall have 6 and exercise all the powers of the judge and perform all the 7 duties required of said judge, and shall be empowered to 8 sign and issue all processes and papers, and to do all acts 9 as fully and with the same effect as the judge could do were 10 he acting in the premises; and the signature of the recorder

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II as such, shall be sufficient evidence of his right to act
I2 instead of the judge. When the office of judge is vacant,
I3 the recorder shall be entitled to the fees; in all other cases
I4 he shall be paid by the judge. Said recorder shall reside
I5 in Bath, and shall hold his office until another is appointed
I6 in his stead.

Sect. 2. The judge of said court may tax and shall be 2 allowed for his services in criminal proceedings the same 3 fees and at the same rates as are allowed by law to trial 4 justices for like services, except that his fee for a complaint 5 and warrant shall be one dollar; one dollar and twenty-five 6 cents for entering complaint, swearing witnesses, rendering 7 and recording judgment, allowing and taxing the costs 8 and filing papers; fifty cents for making and recording each 9 libel of intoxicating liquors; twenty-five cents for order of 10 notice and twenty-five cents for executing order to deliver, 11 and for the trial of a complaint two dollars for each day 12 engaged therein; all of which fees shall inure to the city of 13 Bath.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
