STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the county of York to procure a loan.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the county of York is
2 authorized to procure by loan on the faith and responsibility
3 of said county, a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand
4 dollars, exclusive of and in addition to loans authorized by
5 section seventeen of chapter seventy-eight of the Revised
6 Statutes, for the purpose of funding the floating debt of said
7 county, and the said treasurer is hereby authorized to issue
8 bonds of said county with interest coupons attached, to the
9 amount of such loan; said bonds to bear interest, payable
10 semi-annually, at a rate not exceeding four per centum per
11 annum, the principal to be payable at such times, not later
12 than ten years from the date thereof, as the county com-

13 missioners of York county may fix, said bonds to be signed
14 by the treasurer and countersigned by the county commis-
15 sioners of said county, and said bonds to be of not larger
16 denomination than five hundred dollars each.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the
2 Governor.
