STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT authorizing Cities and Towns to accept Conveyances upon Trusts in Public Burial Places, and providing for the Record of Deeds of Burial Lots.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. When any person owning or interested in a
2 lot in a public burial place in a city or town deposits with
3 the treasurer of such city or town, a sum of money for the
4 preservation or care of such lot as provided by section 1,
5 chapter 145 of the Public Laws of 1887, said city or town
6 may accept a conveyance of such lot for the uses and upon
7 the trusts which may be set forth in said conveyance, and

8 may bind itself to keep and perform the agreements, uses
9 and trusts as are contained in the deed of conveyance of such
10 lot.

Sect. 2. Deeds of burial lots in any public cemetery may
2 be recorded with the registry of deeds for the county or
3 district where such cemetery is situated.
