STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the State Reform School.

Resolved, That the sum of forty-eight thousand five hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the State Reform School for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-seven and eighteen hundred and ninety-eight for the following purposes: For the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, for current expenses including mechanical school and Farrington cottage eighteen thousand five hundred dollars; to complete and furnish new cottage, eight thousand five hundred dollars; ordinary repairs, one thousand dollars. For the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, for current expenses including mechanical school and Farrington cottage, nineteen thousand five hundred dollars; for ordinary repairs one thousand dollars.
