STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Calais Academy.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated annually for two years to aid Calais
3 Academy.

Provided, however, that this appropriation is made upon
5 the express condition that the trustees of said institution
6 shall maintain and keep in operation for at least twenty-
7 four weeks per year a school equal in rank and grade of
8 teaching, with a first-class academy, and that if in the opin-
9 ion of the governor and council said institution shall fail to
10 fulfill this condition they may, in their discretion, withhold
11 the appropriation herein granted.
