IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to legalize the doings of School District No. Five
in the town of Falmouth, and of the Trustees of the Crispus
Graves' Fund, so called, and to enable said Trustees to
convey and the Inhabitants of said Falmouth to purchase
the school building erected out of said fund in said district.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

That the acts and doings of the trustees of the fund given
2 by the will of the late Crispus Graves, to School District
3 Number Five, in the town of Falmouth, in the county of
4 Cumberland, and known as the Crispus Graves' Fund, in
5 the erection of a school building in said district, out of
6 said fund, and the acts and doings of said School District

7 in the erection of said school building are hereby legalized
8 and made valid, and the said trustees and their successors
9 are hereby authorized to sell and convey to the inhabitants
10 of said town of Falmouth said school building, so erected
11 as aforesaid, and the inhabitants of said town of Falmouth,
12 are hereby authorized to purchase said school building
13 from said trustees or their successors.
