RESOLVE in favor of building a bridge over the Daigle brook  
in the town of Van Buren and county of Aroostook.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars be  
2 and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of building a  
3 bridge over a gully, to be known as the Daigle Bridge in the  
4 town of Van Buren and county of Aroostook, to the satis-  
5 faction of the county commissioners of said county, and  
6 when so completed and approved by said commissioners,  
7 said town of Van Buren may draw on the treasurer of the  
8 State of Maine for sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, as  
9 above named.
