STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit the Manufacture and Sale of Cigarettes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever, by himself, his clerk, servant or
2 agent, directly or indirectly, manufactures for sale, sells,
3 offers for sale, has in his possession with intent to sell, or
4 gives away, any cigarette, shall be punished by fine not
5 exceeding fifty dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding
6 sixty days.

Sect. 2. Trial justices and municipal and police courts
2 have jurisdiction of offences described in the preceding
3 section.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect May 1, 1897.
