STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to incorporate the Nahmakanta Steamboat Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Joseph P. Bass, Millard E. Mudgett, James
2 Rice, Clarence S. Lunt, James B. Mullen, Charles W. Mullen
3 and W. R. Stratton, their associates, successors and assigns,
4 are hereby incorporated under the name of the Nahmakanta
5 Steamboat Company, for the purpose of navigating the
6 North Twin, South Twin, Pemadumcook and Umbajejus
7 lakes and their tributaries, located in the counties of Penob-
8 scot and Piscataquis, with stream, for the conveyance of pas-

9 sengers and freight, with the right to charge a reasonable
10 compensation therefor, with all the rights and privileges,
11 and subject to all the liabilities and obligations of similar
12 corporations. Said company is authorized to clear channels
13 and dredge bars in said lakes or any of their tributaries, and
14 to build, purchase and own steamboats, barges, scows and
15 other property necessary to carry out the purposes of the
16 organization, and may own and hold real estate, and build
17 and maintain necessary piers and wharves.

Sect. 2. Said company, its successors and assigns, shall
2 have the exclusive right to exercise the powers given it by
3 this act, for the term of twenty years from the first day of
4 July, 1897, provided said company shall commence running
5 a steamboat or steamboats upon said lakes within two years
6 from said July 1st, 1897, and provided further that nothing
7 in this act shall prevent the Penobscot Log Driving Com-
8 pany from using steamboats upon said lakes or any of their
9 tributaries, for the purposes of towing and driving logs and
10 lumber, and of transporting men and supplies therefor, or
11 interfere with the driving, rafting and booming of logs
12 across said lakes, or upon any streams adjacent thereto.

Sect. 3. The capital stock of said company shall not exceed
2 twenty thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred
3 dollars each.

Sect. 4. The first meeting of said corporation shall be
2 called at Bangor, in the county of Penobscot, by any one
3 of the corporators named in section 1. The notice of such

4 meeting shall be delivered in hand to each of the corpora-
5 tors named in this act.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
