STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to grant the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and
Game authority to destroy Mink in and around all Fish
Hatcheries in the State.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The commissioners of inland fisheries and
2 game shall have authority to cause the destruction of all
3 mink found in or around any fish hatchery or feeding station
4 in this State, and section 20 of chapter 30 of the Revised
5 Statutes is hereby modified to this extent.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
