STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section seven, chapter two hundred forty-
nine of the Public Laws of 1893.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 7, chapter 249, Public Laws of 1893
2 is hereby amended by adding at the close of said section
3 the following words 'or dip nets no individual to take
4 more than one-half bushel of smelts at any one time with
5 dip nets' so that said section as amended shall read as
6 follows:

'Section 7. In Georges river above a line drawn from
8 Hooper's Point in the town of Saint George westerly past

9 the northerly end of Caldwell's Island to a point opposite
10 on the shore in the town of Cushing or to take smelts in
11 said river and its tributaries in any other way than by hook
12 and line, or dip nets, no individual to take more than one-
13 half bushel of smelts at any one time with dip nets.'
