STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Potter Academy of Sebago.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars is hereby
2 annually appropriated for the term of two years to Potter
3 Academy, an institution of learning in Sebago, county of
4 Cumberland.

Provided, however, that the appropriation is made upon
6 the express condition that the trustees of said institution
7 shall maintain and keep in operation a school equal in rank
8 and grade of teaching with a first-class academy of not less
9 than three terms of ten weeks during each year; and pro-
10 vided further that the governor and council and superinten-
11 dent of common schools shall have a right at all times to
12 visit said school when the same shall be in operation, and if
13 in the opinion of the governor and council, said institution
14 at any time hereafter shall fail to fulfill the conditions of this
15 resolve, they may in their discretion withhold the appropria-
16 tion herein granted.
