IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section 6 of chapter 413 of the Private
Special Laws of 1850, entitled An Act to incorporate the
City of Hallowell.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Amend section 6 of the city charter by adding
2 thereto the following:

'The board of overseers of the poor shall be appointed by
4 the city council, and shall hold office for a term of one year
5 or three years as the city council may determine; but when
6 the term of office is fixed for three years, the first overseer
7 shall be appointed for three years, the second overseer for
8 two years and the third overseer for one year; and each

9 year thereafter one overseer shall be appointed for three
10 years.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
