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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE providing for the Preservation of the Regimental  
Rolls in the Adjutant General's Office.

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*Resolved,* That the adjutant general is hereby authorized  
2 and directed under the advice and control of the governor  
3 and council to provide for the preservation of the enlist-  
4 ment, descriptive and muster rolls and the monthly returns  
5 of regiments and batteries in the War of the Rebellion, now  
6 on file in the adjutant general's office.

*Resolved,* That the sum of five hundred dollars for the year  
8 1897, and five hundred dollars for the year 1898 is hereby  
9 appropriated for the preservation of said rolls.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These resolves are substantially a renewal of the resolves approved March 27, 1895, under which an appropriation of five hundred dollars for each of the years 1895 and 1896 was made for the purposes set forth. It has been found that the work of binding the rolls is necessarily quite slow and expensive and the appropriation asked for is the amount estimated for the work that can be done in each year on the rolls, and for continuing the collection of historical data.
