RESOLVE in favor of a road in Dallas Plantation.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred dollars be and  
2 hereby is appropriated out of any money in the treasury of  
3 the State for repairing and maintaining the road in Dallas  
4 plantation between Rangeley and Dead River station in  
5 Franklin county, the same to be expended under the direc-  
6 tion of the county commissioners of said county in the years  
7 1897 and 1898.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road is some four miles long; was opened to the public about two years ago; some seventeen hundred dollars (\$1,700) has been expended on it. It is stony and hard to build. It does not accommodate those in the plantation. It is traveled largely by sportsmen and traveling salesmen. The plantation cannot be taxed but little to support this road as they have their own to maintain.
