RESOLVE in favor of a road in Jerusalem Plantation.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred dollars be and  
2 hereby is appropriated out of any money in the treasury of  
3 the State for repairing and maintaining the road from Drew's  
4 Mills in Jerusalem plantation in Franklin county to the main  
5 road in Dead River plantation in Somerset county, the same  
6 to be expended under the direction of the county commis-  
7 sioners of Franklin county in the years 1897 and 1898.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road is about five miles long. Some twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500) has been expended on it. Franklin county has put in some five hundred dollars. We tax the plantation all we can to put onto this piece of road. It is a hard place to build a road, and keep it up as heavy teams pass over this road.
