STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a weir in tide waters
on Sheep's Cove Ledge, in Pennamaquan river, in Pembroke,
county of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Thompson Wilbur of Pembroke, in the county
2 of Washington, or whoever may be the owner of what is
3 known as Sheep's Cove Ledge, in tide waters in Pennama-
4 quan river, in the town of Pembroke, is hereby authorized
5 to build and maintain a weir for fishing purposes on said
6 ledge; providing the same does not interfere with navigation
7 or the rights of shore owners.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
