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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to extend the charter of the Lewiston, Augusta and  
Camden Railroad Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The time within which the Lewiston, Augusta  
2 and Camden Railroad Company, a corporation created by  
3 chapter two hundred and seventy-eight of the Private and  
4 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, as  
5 amended by chapter six hundred and twenty-six of the  
6 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-  
7 three, and chapter two hundred and fifty-two of the Private  
8 and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, may  
9 file its locations and commence operations for building its  
10 lines, is hereby extended to July one, eighteen hundred and  
11 ninety-nine.
