STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend an act incorporating the Saco River Tele-
graph and Telephone Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 3 of chapter 432 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1889 as amended by chapter 103 of the Pri-
3 vate and Special Laws of 1895, is hereby further amended by
4 adding after the word "of" in the fifth line the word 'Alfred.'

Sect. 2. Section 2 of said chapter 432 is hereby amended
2 so as to read as follows: 'Said corporation is hereby
3 empowered and authorized to own, construct, maintain and
4 operate from some point in the city of Biddeford, a line or
5 lines of telegraph and telephone through the city of Saco

6 and the towns of Buxton, Hollis and Standish, and branch
7 lines within said towns. The location of all poles and lines
8 under this charter are to be subject to such regulations as
9 the municipal officers of said cities and towns shall prescribe.'
