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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to permit the Good Will Home Association to  
increase its capital and to enlarge its purpose to include Aid  
for Needy Girls.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Good Will Home Association, a charitable  
2 corporation formed under the provisions of chapter fifty-  
3 five of the Revised Statutes, for the purpose of aiding needy  
4 boys, and located at East Fairfield in Somerset county is  
5 hereby authorized to take and hold by purchase, gift, devise,  
6 or bequest, personal or real estate, in all not exceeding five  
7 hundred thousand dollars owned at any one time.

Sect. 2. By a unanimous vote of all its members present  
2 at any annual meeting, notice of the proposed action having  
3 been given by some member in the Good Will Record, at  
4 least one month prior thereto, that the same would be, pre-  
5 sented at such meeting, the objects and purposes of said  
6 corporation may be enlarged to include the furnishing of aid  
7 to needy girls.
