STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend chapter 229 of the Private and Special Laws of 1849, entitled "An Act incorporating the trustees of the fund for the support of the Episcopate of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the diocese of Maine," as amended by chapter 311 of the laws of 1864, as amended by chapter 214 of the laws of 1880, and as amended by chapter 106 of the laws of 1895.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 229 of the Private and Special Laws of 2 1849, as amended by chapter 311 of the laws of 1864, as 3 amended by chapter 214 of the laws of 1880, and as amended

4 by chapter 106 of the laws of 1895, is hereby further amended
5 so as to read as follows:

‘Section 1. The trustees of the diocesan funds in the di-
7 cese of Maine shall have power to take and hold real and
8 personal estate contributed for parochial endowments or
9 other church purposes to the amount of two hundred thou-
10 sand dollars and to manage and dispose of the same in
11 accordance with the terms of the several gifts, grants or
12 endowments, and said trustees shall keep an account with
13 each endowment or gift comprising said fund and report
14 their doings in managing the same and the condition thereof
15 to the convention of the diocese annually.’

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
