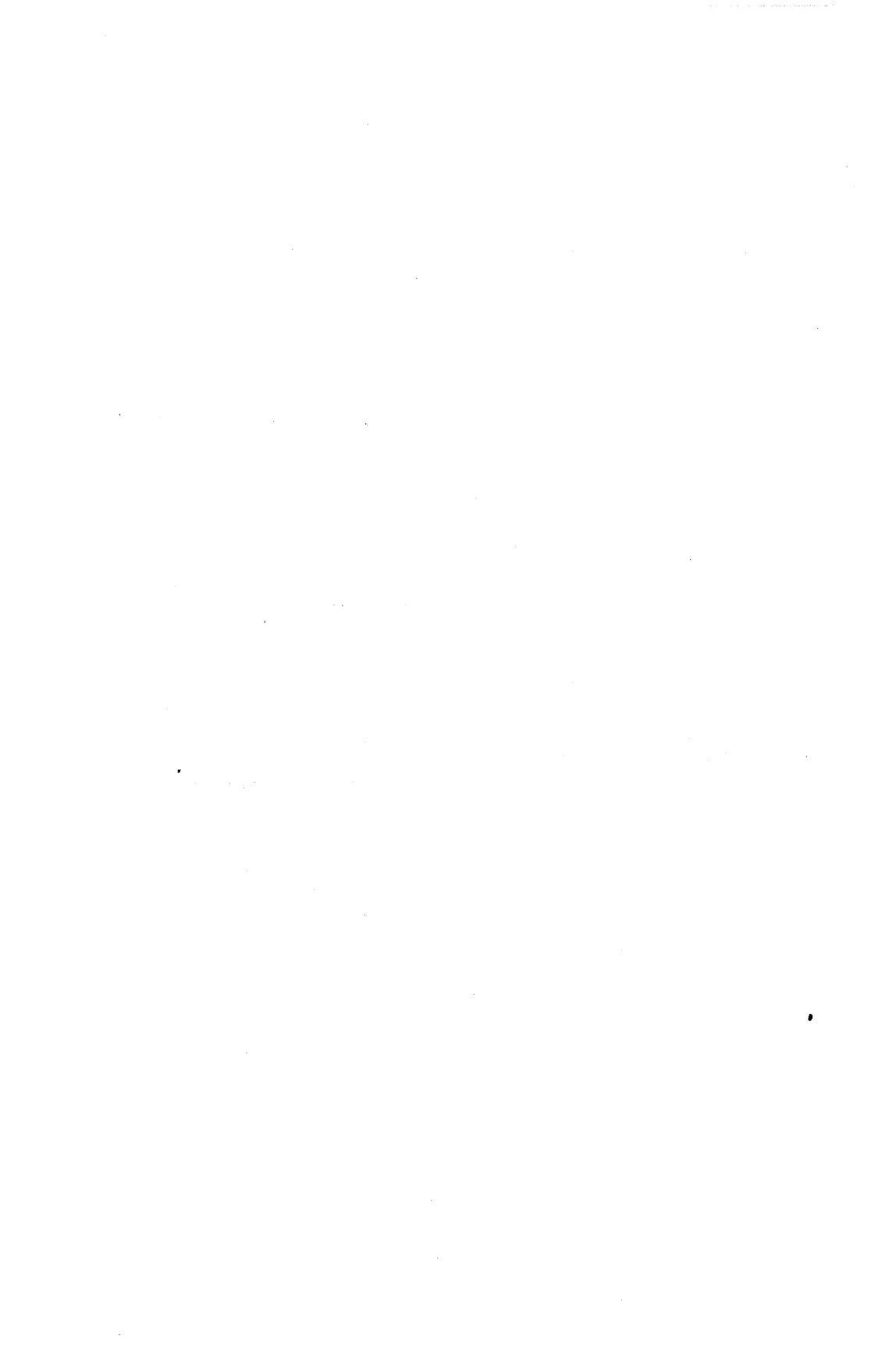
AN ACT granting additional powers to the Long Pond Water
Company, incorporated under chapter five hundred and
twenty-four of the Private and Special Laws of the year
eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Long Pond Water Company, incorporated
2 under the provisions of chapter five hundred and twenty-
3 four of the private and special laws of the year eighteen hun-
4 dred and eighty-five, is hereby authorized and empowered to
5 locate, lay, construct and maintain its sluices, aqueducts
6 and pipes under, across and through the tide waters of Bass
7 cove, an arm of Flanders bay in the town of Sullivan, Han-

8 cock county, Maine, within the limits of the location of said
9 company, provided, however, that said company shall not
10 thereby unnecessarily obstruct navigation.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
