IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend and extend the charter of the Ellsworth Street Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 391 of the private and 2 special laws of 1889, entitled "An act to incorporate the 3 Ellsworth Street Railway Company," is hereby amended by 4 inserting after the word "power," in the fifth line of said 5 section, the words 'or by compressed air.'

Sect. 2. The rights, powers and privileges of said Ells-2 worth Street Railway Company which were granted by 3 chapter three hundred and ninety-one of the private and 4 special laws for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine,

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5 as extended and enlarged by chapter five hundred fif-6 teen of the private and special laws for the year eighteen 7 hundred and ninety-three, chapter eighty-one of the private 8 and special laws for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-9 five, and by section one of this act, are hereby extended for 10 two years additional; and the persons named in said acts, 11 their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, 12 powers and privileges that were granted them by said acts, 13 or that are herein granted, to be exercised for the same pur-14 poses as specified in said acts.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
