STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT relating to the April term of the Supreme Judicial Court in the County of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. From and after the day this act takes effect the 2 annual April term of the supreme judicial court now held 3 at Houlton, in the county of Aroostook, on the fourth Tues-4 day of April, shall be held at said Houlton on the third Tues-5 day of April, in each year, forever. And the court, at every 6 said April term, upon the completion of the business con-7 veniently triable therein at said Houlton, shall and is hereby 8 required and directed to adjourn to Caribou, in said county, 9 to there complete such civil business pending in said court, 10 as ought to be and may be more conveniently there tried

and heard; and the jurors in attendance at said court, except grand jurors, may be required to attend such adjournment, or may be discharged or new jurors summoned, as the cirtumstances may require. The clerk of said court shall receive from said county, for his attendance and expenses at Caribou, during said adjournment part of said term, in addition to his compensation now allowed by law, such further sum as the presiding justice shall determine.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the twentieth day of 2 May, eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.
